## **Subject: Eligibility for Emergency Vehicle license plates**

Dear Commissioner,

Per Va. Code § 46.2-649.1:1, ambulances and other emergency vehicles belonging to the following corporations are primary components of the Virginia Beach Emergency Medical Services system, and should be considered eligible for permanent Emergency Vehicle ("EV") license plates:

- Chesapeake Beach Volunteer Rescue Squad
- Creeds Volunteer Rescue Squad
- Davis Corner Volunteer Rescue Squad
- Kempsville Volunteer Rescue Squad
- Ocean Park Volunteer Rescue Squad
- Plaza Volunteer Rescue Squad
- Princess Anne Courthouse Volunteer Rescue Squad
- Sandbridge Volunteer Rescue Squad
- Virginia Beach Volunteer Rescue Squad
- Virginia Beach Volunteer Water Rescue Team, Inc.
