APPROVED RESTOCKING RULES

Acronyms:

- ▶ VBLS = Virginia Beach Lifesaving Service (lifeguards)
- ▶ VBFD = Virginia Beach Fire Department
- ▶ VBDEMS = Virginia Beach Department of EMS
- ▶ VRS = Volunteer Rescue Squad

What kind of unit used the supply?	ELIGIBLE SOURCE FOR RESTOCKING	
	At time of patient turnover, if conducted	Otherwise
VBLS	Ambulance	VBLS
VBFD	Ambulance	VBFD --or-- Hospital (Complete non-transport restock form!)
Zone	Ambulance	VBDEMS (city) stock --or-- The VRS that a member on the zone unit belongs to --or-- Hospital (Complete non-transport restock form!)
Ambulance	Hospital	The VRS that the unit belongs to --or-- The VRS that any member on the unit belongs to --or-- Hospital (Complete non-transport restock form!)

TEMS Regional Protocols Appendix F (Restocking Policy) always applies.

The following are NEVER AUTHORIZED across agency/departmental/VRS lines:

- ▶ Bulk restocking (boxes of gloves, lancets, etc)
- ▶ Delegating restock of a USED IV/Drug/RSI box to a provider who did not treat or transport the associated patient.
- ▶ Restocking an item NOT included in the TEMS Restocking Policy
 - ◆ Example: NON-intubated (nasal cannula style) ETCO2 Sampling Lines
