Plaza Volunteer Rescue Squad's *Operation Safehaven*

Plaza Volunteer Rescue Squad has conducted Operation Safehaven on October 31st each year for decades. The event operates from 6:00 pm – 8:00 pm at the Virginia Beach Fire & Rescue Station 16 at 2610 S. Plaza Trail. This is Plaza Volunteer Rescue Squad's SAFE alternative to children roaming the neighborhood streets at night.

Normally, the EMS side of the station was transformed into a scary Haunted House and the apparatus bays were turned into a huge game room. However, this year due to Coronavirus concerns, Operation Safehaven was modified for everyone's safety.

Plaza Rescue has coordinated with Princess Anne Plaza Baptist Church, which is located directly behind the station, to hold the event. Operation Safehaven will be a combined drive-thru event with the Church membership. Vehicles will enter Princess Anne Plaza Baptist Church at 245 S. Rosemont Rd. They will be guided down the road behind the Church, through the gate and onto the Rescue Station driveway. Along the way, members from the Plaza Volunteer Rescue Squad, as well as Princess Anne Plaza Baptist Church will be handing out candy and treat bags to the children.
