

The city's web site now makes it possible for you to pull address lists simply by drawing borders on the map – and it's completely free.

The name of this system is: VBGOV GIS Property Map

It looks like this:




If you click the "By Shape" tab...




Then click the "Polygon" button...



You can draw a polygon around an area. For this example, I've drawn borders around Oceana Naval Air Station:



When you're done, you "double-click", wait, and you get something like this:



Notice that ***all*** the addresses in your polygon show up in a column near the bottom left. If you click the "Options" drop-down...



Then "Export All to CSV" ...



You can download a CSV file that you can open in your spreadsheet program. You can also send the CSV file to me to be merged into your OscarTRACK/KEYclick database if you are using that system. In OscarTRACK/KEYclick, we can perform "trespass detection", and the results will be shared with the appropriate squads to facilitate a resolution prior to mailing.
